Thank you for your expression of interest in the children's art exhibition **Tomorrowland** curated by Sorami Ochi.

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

This exhibition provides kindergarten and primary school-aged children living in Far North Queensland the opportunity to have their artwork exhibited at an art gallery and receive public recognition for their creativity and skills. This exhibition will be launched to coincide with the **Cairns Children's Festival in May 2025** at the **Court House Gallery**.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- **Kindergarten** and **primary school-aged children** (and their older siblings) living in Far North Queensland.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- Interested artists are asked to create an **original artwork** that represents the future. It could be a futuristic representation of our region, a special place or how we interact and do things.
- Artists may enter more than one artwork (up to three artworks will be accepted).
- Artworks can be **any size and medium** including, but not limited to drawings or paintings on paper or canvas and sculptures.
- Artworks must be **unframed** and **unlaminated**.

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete an application form digitally or handwritten (**one application form per artwork**).
- Send completed application form and photo of artwork to sorami.o@outlook.com by **1 April 2025, 11:59 pm** with the subject line as Tomorrowland Exhibition.

SELECTION PROCESS

A selection panel will review all applications and assess them against the selection criteria:

- Artistic quality and originality.
- Addresses the exhibition theme.

All successful applicants will be contacted via email after **10 April 2025** with information regarding **when** and **where** accepted artworks must be delivered.

Please note: This is a curated exhibition. Not all entries will be accepted. Only successful applicants will be notified of their outcome.
